The SDFM National Board of Directors approved a membership dues increase effective January 1, 2025. One-year individual dues increased from \$50 per year to \$55 and three-year individual dues increased from \$120 per year to \$132. - 2)The recipient of the scholarship, along with their high school counselor, will be notified via email by 31 March 2025, and the recipient is required to attend the SDFM RSA-HSV chapter June 2025 awards and scholarship meeting.
