Discussion Highlights:

1. Opening Remarks (Ms. Debbie O'Neal):
 - Ms. O'Neal chaired the meeting as Mr. Bacon was away for training. He sent his regards and expressed his hope to see everyone at the upcoming chapter picnic.
2. Treasurer's Update (Ms. Tina Hinze):
 - Ms. Hinze presented the financial statements for March and April. She noted that the chapter is in a good financial position, with the joint luncheon having been profitable. A significant

topic was the ongoing delay with the IRS regarding the chapter's name change, which is preventing the update of the name on the bank account. Ms. Hinze has sent another letter to the IRS to expedite the matter. The board also discussed the need for a list of scholarship recipients from Lauren Cunningham to process the payments. A motion was made and seconded to approve the financial statements, and the motion passed. The board is still awaiting information from National regarding any potential rebates from the DFMI regional conference.

3. Upcoming Luncheon and Communications (Ms. Rebecca Hunt):

- The annual picnic is scheduled for May 14th at the Overlook, with Full Moon catering. As of the meeting, 31 people had registered. The deadline for catering numbers is Monday, so an email reminder will be sent out. The committee plans to add a buffer of about five extra meals to the final count. The board also discussed sending reminders for voting.

4. Memberships, Awards, Scholarships (Ms. Debbie O'Neal):

- Ms. Cunningham, through Ms. O'Neal, announced the three recipients of the \$1,000 scholarships: Ella Pritchett (New Hope High School), Zabian Miller (Hazel Green High School), and Lilly Hartsford (Austin High School). These students will be recognized at the June luncheon. Nominations for the 4th Quarter Member of the Quarter and Member of the Year awards are open until June 9th.

5. Nominations and Elections (Ms. Rebecca Hunt):

- Ms. Hunt reported a strong turnout for voting on the new board members but noted that several positions are currently tied. She urged board members to encourage anyone who has not yet voted to do so by the May 12th deadline. Tie-breaking procedures will be implemented if necessary. The winners will be announced at the picnic on May 14th.

6. Community Service/Chapter Competition (Ms. Debbie O'Neal):

- Ms. O'Neal was pleased to announce that the chapter has won the Community Service Award from National and has maintained its five-star status. The awards will be presented in Orlando. Mr. Bacon will attempt to attend the ceremony to accept the awards on the chapter's behalf.

7. Committee Updates:

- Newsletter (Ms. Cynthia Johnson): The deadline for content submission for the next newsletter is the 15th of the month.
- Programs (Ms. TeAsia Cunningham): Ms. Cunningham is actively seeking a speaker for the June luncheon, as the previously suggested speaker has a scheduling conflict. This luncheon will also include the installation of the new officers.
- Webmaster (Mr. Thaddeus Blake): Mr. Blake reported that the website is up-to-date.
