Jan 9, 2025 PDE Topic: SDFM Audit Task Force Update

The Redstone Arsenal (RSA) Huntsville (HSV) Chapter of the Society of Defense Financial Management (SDFM) is seeking applicants for their annual Chapter Scholarships.

The Chapter will award Scholarships up to \$2,000 at the June 2025 SDFM RSA-HSV Awards and Scholarship meeting.

1)This Scholarship is offered to any graduating high school senior that has shown exemplary leadership and service in their community, has received outstanding scholastic achievements, or has experienced financial hardship AND is interested in continuing their education in the finance/accounting/business discipline during the 2025-26 academic year.

-Most recent official academic transcript

- -Two academic letters of recommendation on official letterhead
- -Copy of standardized test score supporting score cited on the application
- -College acceptance correspondence (acceptance letter or email)
- 2)The recipient of the scholarship, along with their high school counselor, will be notified via email by 31 March 2025, and the recipient is required to attend the SDFM RSA-HSV chapter June 2025 awards and scholarship meeting.
